DESCRIPTION DU COURS

Cours de niveau avancé destiné aux étudiants qui désirent perfectionner leur anglais oral et écrit. Ce cours vise à amener l'étudiant à s'exprimer correctement tant à l'oral qu'à l'écrit et à poursuivre des études supérieures en anglais. Il est réservé aux étudiants dont la langue maternelle n'est pas l'anglais avec un classement avancé.

OBJECTIFS

The general objective of this course is to give students concrete tools and skills so that they can communicate with increased confidence and accuracy. This course will give students a deeper understanding of how the English language works and give them an opportunity to apply this understanding in both oral and written communicative activities. At the end of the course, students:

- can introduce and clearly develop, with increased accuracy, their ideas on a variety of topics both orally and in writing. Topics will vary from those of general interest to those which are directly related to the individual student's areas of expertise and interest.
- can read and understand authentic university-level texts.
- will have broadened their lexical comprehension.
- will better understand intermediate and advanced language structures and be able to apply this knowledge with increasing accuracy to their written and oral production.
- will have improved their writing strategies and self-editing skills and be able to produce more effective written texts using a variety of sentence structures, transitional words, and better vocabulary choices.

CONTENUS

Grammar is presented communicatively and gradually: determiners; modifiers; prepositions; perfect verb forms; passive; past modals; gerunds and infinitives; compound-complex, and reduced sentences using coordinating and subordinating connectors.

Multi-skilled activities covering oral production and comprehension, written production, and comprehension.
